

Minutes of Leesburg Township Regular Meeting

Monday, May 3, 2021

The Trustees of Leesburg Township met in a regular session.

Members present: Chairman Jeff Robinson, Vice-Chairman Kevin Dotson, Bill Lowe and Fiscal Officer Mellisa Weigand.

Others in attendance: Chief Cook, Ben Laird, Dave Cook, Evan Jamison, Casey Rausch & Deputy Rocklin

Jeff Robinson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. The trustees reviewed the April 5, 2021 meeting minutes. Kevin made a motion, seconded by Bill, to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

Old Business:

Jeff contacted Pathmaster for status on our repair. They said they are still waiting on parts.

Michael Kinney paid the BZA for a variance on his property requesting an easement to hook into tile for drainage. He was able to hook into existing tile on his own property. Bill moved to refund Michael Kinney his money, seconded by Kevin, for an easement because he's able to utilize his own property for his needs.

Evan Jamison reported on clean up day. He brought eight 30-ton dumpsters and one 20-ton in total on clean up day. There was also a discussion regarding the Estep property. The court granted Leesburg Township permission to clean up the property (see document attached). Evan informed the Trustees that the camper may be expensive for him to get rid of and suggested calling Kirby's to take it. Bill made a motion to start the clean up process on Estep property on May 14th at 7:00 a.m., motion seconded by Kevin, motion passes unanimously.

New Business

Casey, UC Engineers office, brought documents for this years road repair expenses (see attached documents). Bill motioned to accept the proposed road maintenance, seconded by Kevin, motion passed unanimously.

Ben reported that the BZA is having a meeting June 2 regarding a variance concerning the 3:1 ratio. The June township meeting will also hear the proposed amendments to the Leesburg Township Zoning Resolution.

Ben let the Trustees know that he asked Alan Fitzpatrick to assist in digging the footer holes for the flagpoles at Hopewell Cemetery and Maple Dell Cemetery. There was discussion on where to put the Maple Dell flagpole and the date.

Chief Cook is retiring from his position in Allen Twp. at the end of the year. He discussed with the Trustees the possibility of him taking on a 40 hour work week for a specified dollar amount with part time help at the firehouse. Chief will put together a spreadsheet, for the next meeting, with possible hours and cost of staffing the firehouse this way. This may be an option to try before asking the voters to approve another levy to staff the firehouse.

Chief Cook suggested Corey Schalip take on a role as Prevention Officer because the fire department paid for his training.

Chief Cook proposed to the Trustees purchasing a Vollara Air & Surface Pro. It is an air purifying system that can kill all air borne germs and even reaches the air duct system in the building. This is a great asset for the firehouse to clean the meeting room and surrounding area. Bill made a motion, seconded by Kevin, to purchase the system with CARES Act funds.


Chief also brought up the fact that they need new radios for the firemen and trucks to stay updated with the system used by all the emergency personnel and the Sheriff. This may also be a cost covered by the CARES Act. There will be a fire extinguisher demo at the firehouse May 4th for a new type of extinguisher.

There is not a copy machine in the meeting room at the firehouse. Kevin made a motion, seconded by Bill, to purchase one for the meeting room. Motion passed unanimously.

The F.O. circulated warrants, purchase orders, vouchers and receipts for trustee approval. Bill made a motion, seconded by Kevin, to adjourn the board meeting. The motion passed unanimously.



ENTRY GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S REQUESTED RELIEF

THIS MATTER COMING BEFORE THE COURT on Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment. Upon careful review of the proceedings regarding Plaintiff's Motion, the Court finds and orders as follows:

1. Defendant's Property located at 12142 State Route 347, Marysville, OH 43040 shall be declared a Nuisance pursuant to R.C. § 505.87.
2. Plaintiff, by its employees, contractors, or other designee are authorized, without cost or further notice, to enter upon the Defendant's Property located at 12142 State Route 347, Marysville, OH 43040, and also identified as Union County Parcel No. 2000200640000, to abate, control, or remove and dispose of the


3. vegetation, garbage refuse, or other debris which Plaintiff has determined to be a nuisance.
4. Plaintiff shall make a written report to the county auditor of its actions under R.C. §505.87, which shall include a proper description of the Property and a statement of all expenses incurred in providing for the abatement, control, or removal of any vegetation, garbage, refuse, or other debris, including the board's charges for its services, the costs incurred in providing notice, any fees or interest paid to borrow moneys, and the amount paid for labor, materials, and equipment.
5. The expenses incurred, when allowed, shall be entered upon the tax duplicate and become a lien upon Defendant's Property from the date of the entry, shall be collected as other taxes, and shall be returned to the township and placed in the township general fund.
