Minutes of Leesburg Township Meeting
Held Monday, January 5th, 2009**

The Trustees of Leesburg Township met in regular session at the Leesburg Township Fire/Road Maintenance and Storage Facility at 7:30 PM.

The following members were present: Bill Lowe, Jeff Robinson, Gary Cunningham and Clerk, Annette Chapman.

Others in attendance were: Fire Chief, Jim Hall, Zoning Inspector Ben Laird, Deputy Haycox, Dan Karcher and Malcolm Manville.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, William Lowe.

Minutes of the meeting held December 15, 2008, were read and approved. Gary Cunningham made the motion to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by William Lowe. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes)

Election of new officers for the year 2009 is as follows: Nomination of Jeff Robinson - Chairman and Gary Cunningham as Vice Chairman. Motion by William Lowe to accept the officers as nominated. Seconded by Gary Cunningham. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2009-1)

Old Business:

Fire Chief Hall reported fire truck 303 will be in service in 10 days. All repairs and additions are completed.

Hall also reported the overhead doors in the building were adjusted and are leaking air - the top rubber seal is now not sealing properly. Jeff Robinson will call Joey and will have the repair team back out for more adjustments.

Zoning Inspector, Ben Laird, reported the Greer property now looked satisfactory so no need to pursue the zoning violation.

Ben was asked if he had visited the Pine Lane property that was reported to look like a junk yard and he had not yet visited this property but will stop by before the next meeting.

New Business:

Dan Karcher, fireman, requested the Township help purchase first responder jackets for the firemen. The cost of the coats is \$183.00 each and the department is requesting \$90 per coat from the Trustees. The Trustees would like to do something for the firemen in lieu of a Christmas party for 2007 and 2008. Jeff Robinson moved the township cover \$90 of the cost of the first responder jackets with the balance to be paid by the firemen themselves. Bill Lowe seconded this motion. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2009-2)

Deputy Haycox delivered the November 2008 stats and reported no new news on the speed signs for the Township. The Deputy and Trustees then discussed the location of these signs within the Township. Haycox will continue working to get information and will report next month.

Bill Lowe moved we continue using Jean Smith as clerk for the Zoning Boards and again pay Jean \$100 per Zoning meeting and we remind Jean (by way of a letter) that she needs to copy Fiscal Officer, Annette Chapman, on all Zoning correspondence and minutes. Bill also moved we continue paying the Zoning Board members \$10 per meeting. In addition Zoning Inspector pay will continue at \$150 per month. Gary Cunningham seconded this motion. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2009-3)

Gary Cunningham moved Leesburg Township continue paying Fire Chief, Jim Hall, \$100 per month along with \$10 per run and per meeting and pay both Assistant Fire Chief/Mechanics, Kevin Dotson and Malcolm Manville, Assistant Fire Chief/Station, \$600 per year and \$10 per run and per meeting and announce their new titles. In addition each fireman will be continue to be reimbursed \$10 per run and \$5 per meeting at the end of 2009. Motion seconded by Bill Lowe. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2009-4)

Gary Cunningham moved that Sexton, Tom Chapman, be paid \$250 for the year 2009 to mow Pine Lane cemetery. Bill Lowe seconded this motion. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2009-5)

Trustees and Clerk's salaries will not change this year according to the State of Ohio's pay chart and according to the Ohio Revised Code for 2009.

Review of the 2009 Appropriations ensued and the suggested figures were presented by Fiscal Officer Chapman. The Trustees also reviewed the 2009 Certificate of the Total Amount from All Sources Available for Expenditures, and Balances. Fiscal Officer Chapman will finalize numbers and have them ready for final approval at the January 19th meeting.

Bill Lowe reported mileage for 2009 is recorded at \$.55 $\frac{1}{2}$ per mile.

At the conclusion of these discussions and with no further business, Bill Lowe moved we adjourn the meeting. Motion seconded by Gary Cunningham. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes)

Other's in attendance: Malcolm Manville and Fire Chief, Jim Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Jeff Robinson.

Minutes of the meeting held January 5th, 2009 were read. William Lowe approved the minutes. Seconded by Gary Cunningham. Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Old Business

Jeff Robinson reported he had spoken with Joey about the overhead door issues and the repairs have since been made.

Jeff also reported he had spoken to Zoning Inspector, Ben Laird, who had made a trip down Pine Lane and didn't notice any junk issues. The Trustees decided they would review the property again in the Spring to insure there wasn't going to be a junk problem in the future.

Bill Lowe reported speaking to some other Zoning Commission members from outside the Township and found that our pay per meeting is low. After discussion it was decided that next year the Trustees should reconsider the per meeting pay.

Fire Chief reported all was going smoothly in the department and the new truck would be in service on January 31st after the repairs to a drain valve were completed.

New Business:

Discussion on interest rates prompted Jeff Robinson to consider checking with the Richwood Bank on possibly reducing the interest rate on the note for the new facility. Robinson will report back on his findings in February.

At the request of Rinehart - Walters - Danner & Associates, the Trustees reviewed the current insurance policy and decided the only change that was needed was to up the value on the UAN computer system to \$5,000.

Gary Cunningham moved the Trustees accept the 2009 Maintenance and Repair of Roads Resolution from the Union County Engineers Office. Bill Lowe seconded this motion. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2009-6)

Bill Lowe suggested the Trustee get the Community Clean-up day on the calendar. After discussion, a tentative date of April 18th was chosen. Lowe will check on dumpster pricing and availability. Clean-up day will be held at the new Township facility, manned by the Volunteer Fire Department.

Clerk, Annette Chapman, presented the 2009 Certificate of the Total Amount from All Sources Available for Expenditures, and Balances. After review Trustee Gary Cunningham moved Trustees accept the Certificate of the Total Amount from All Sources Available for Expenditures and Balances and said Certificate be filed with the Union County Auditor's Office. Motion seconded by Bill Lowe. (Resolution # 2009-7) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Clerk also presented the year 2009 Appropriations. After review and adjustments, Trustee Gary Cunningham moved Trustees accept the 2009 Appropriation and they be filed with the Union County Auditor's Office. Motion seconded by Bill Lowe. (Resolution # 2009-8) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

With no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Bill Lowe, seconded by Gary Cunningham. Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes) and Lowe (yes).

The Trustees of Leesburg Township met in regular session at the Leesburg Township Fire/Road Maintenance and Storage Facility at 7:30 PM.

Others in attendance were: Asst. Fire Chief, Kevin Dotson, Asst. Fire Chief, Malcolm Manville, Zoning Inspector, Ben Laird, Deputy Weller and Deputy Haycox.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Jeff Robinson.

Minutes of the meeting held January 19, 2009, were read, and approved. Bill Lowe made the motion to accept the minutes. Seconded by Gary Cunningham. Vote - Cunningham (yes), Lowe (yes), and Robinson (yes)

Old Business:

Bill Lowe reported that he had been in contact with Allied Waste and they provided the best prices for clean-up day disposal. Dumpsters would be \$320 each with a one time \$65 delivery fee. The Trustees confirmed the date of April 18th to be clean-up day for 2009.

Jeff Robinson reported having spoken with The Richwood Banking Company about reducing the current interest rate on the new facility note. The current rate of 5.5% could be reduced to 4.75% for 5 years at a cost of \$2000. The change would be a savings of \$5100 for the life of the loan. Gary Cunningham moved the Township pay the \$2000 fee to reduce the interest rate from 5.5% to 4.75% for a term of 5 years. Bill Lowe seconded the motion. (Resolution # 2009-9) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Jeff Robinson requested Fiscal Officer Chapman fax a copy of this motion to Nancy Hoffman at The Richwood Banking Company.

Zoning Inspector, Ben Laird, reported things in his area are pretty quiet at this time. He did report there would be 2 new houses going up in the Township.

Laird asked if the Trustees had received an update from the Prosecutor's Office on the outstanding suits. Trustees reported no new news but Lowe would contact Melissa Chase and provide an update at the March 2009 meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Kevin Dotson reported the fire department had received a donation of turn-out gear from Nestles. Trustees suggested Annette Chapman contact Fire Chief Hall and get an address to send a thank you note to Nestles for their generosity.

Dotson also reported fire department training had taken place at the new facility this past Saturday. During this training the department tested the old pump and Dotson reported it hung right in there.

The Department also announced a Fish Fry coming up on April 4th.

Public Safety Officer Weller introduced himself and distributed the 2008 YE report from the Union County Sheriff's office.

The Trustees of Leesburg Township met in regular session at the Leesburg Township Fire/Road Maintenance and Storage Facility at 7:30 PM.

The following members were present: Jeff Robinson, Bill Lowe, Gary Cunningham and Clerk, Annette Chapman.

Others in attendance were: Fire Chief, Jim Hall, Asst. Fire Chief, Kevin Dotson, Malcolm Manville, Zoning Inspector, Ben Laird, John Hower (Insurance) and Deputy Kevin Weller.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Jeff Robinson.

Minutes of the meeting held February 2, 2009, were read and approved. Gary Cunningham made the motion to accept the minutes. Motion was seconded by Bill Lowe. Vote - Cunningham (yes), Lowe (yes), and Robinson (yes)

Old Business:

The overhead doors in the Township Building were once again in need of repair due to damage that occurred when the electric was out. Two new panels will be replaced along with other work that is needed.

The Trustees discussed the final preparation for the April 18th clean up day.

Zoning Inspector, Ben Laird, reported writing a new house permit this month. He also reported there is a court date set for April 14th on the Pit Stop case.

New Business:

John Hower, agent for Rinehart Insurance, provided an overview/update of the current insurance policy. Hower will update policy to reflect any and all new equipment and building contents. Hower reported a decrease in premium for 2009 - down by \$482. He also provided an updated insurance cards to Fire Chief Hall for all vehicles. Hower reminded the Trustees that there is

a \$300 reimbursement clause for any fire department training - Fiscal Officer Chapman will fax copies of Spencer Roush's training costs for 2008 to Hower for reimbursement.

After review of the new policy, Bill Lowe moved we accept the policy updates effective April 6th, 2009. Gary Cunningham seconded this motion. (Resolution # 2009-10) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Fire Chief Hall, Gary Cunningham and Jeff Robinson attended a Grant Workshop in Marion. Jeff Robinson said they learned that any buildings built in 2003 or newer were not eligible for a generator grant, but Fire Chief Hall reported we are eligible for a grant through the State Fire Marshall in the amount of \$10,000 for turn out gear and he would be making application. Robinson also reported having spoken with Vera Gatchell, a grant writer, who is willing to work with the Township on writing of grants as needed. Bill Lowe moved the Trustees approve up to \$1000 to hire Vera Gatchell of Gatchell Grant Resources, Inc. to apply for any grants that could go toward the purchase of a generator for the Township Facility. Gary Cunningham seconded this motion. (Resolution # 2009-11) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Fire Chief Hall reported radios have been mounted in the new truck, they held a training class during the month that allowed them to use the radios as a test.

Malcolm Manville reported that the forks for the tractor are in at Parrotts for pickup.

There was discussion about purchasing new tables and chairs for the Township facility. Bill Lowe made a motion that the Trustees go 50/50 with the Fire Department to purchase six 8' tables and 48 folding chairs or up to \$800 in cost for the Township's 50%. Gary Cunningham seconded this motion. (Resolution # 2009-12) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Fire Chief Hall requested the Trustees consider putting up an awning at the main entrance of the Township Facility.

Others in attendance were: Fire Chief, Jim Hall, Asst. Fire Chief, Malcolm Manville, Zoning Inspector, Ben Laird, Dean Bowsher of Magnetic City Council, Rocky LeMaster, and Sheriff Rocky Nelson.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Jeff Robinson.

Minutes of the meeting held March 2, 2009, were read and approved. Gary Cunningham made the motion to accept the minutes. Seconded by Bill Lowe. Vote - Cunningham (yes), Lowe (yes), and Robinson (yes)

Old Business:

The tables and chairs have been purchased for the Township facility and Fire Chief Hall reported that the Karcher Family (Fireman Dan Karcher's parents) donated table/chairs from the Milford Center school building. For each piece the Fire Department purchased the Karchers donated two. A thank you note has been sent to the Karcher family for the generous donation.

Hall reported still having problems with the overhead doors in the building - new panels have not yet been installed. Jeff Robinson will look into the repairs.

Bill Lowe received reports that the Freemans are still selling vehicles on Route 4, Zoning Inspector Laird confirmed that he believed this to be true. After discussion it was decided that during the meeting with the Prosecutor on April 13th for the Pit Stop case, the Trustees would recommend to Melissa Chase to go ahead and file suite against the Freemans.

New Business:

Dean Bowsher of Magnetic Springs City Council attended the meeting and wanted to report to the Township that the house at 41 Rose Street had been disposed of. This property was an eye sore to the community.

Jeff Robinson asked Zoning Inspector, Ben Laird, about the property at the NE corner of Route 4 and 347. The trash, junk and dog kennels are a real problem. Laird will stop and do some checking on this property.

Gary Cunningham moved that a load of stone be purchased for repairs to Pine Lane. Bill Lowe seconded this motion. (Resolution # 2009-13) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

It was brought to the attention of the Trustees that there is damage to the shelter house at the ball field. Jeff Robinson will call the insurance contact and have an adjustor look at the damage. Gary Cunningham will call Hostettler and schedule repair of the shelter house.

Discussion ensued about the ball field and who has authority over the ball field. Jeff Robinson will research this matter and report back, he will try and contact Curtis Wykoff, Mike Knaul, Matt Hall and Rex Pierce.

Rocky LeMaster attended the meeting and gave the Trustees a receipt for his EMT refresher course that will be reimbursed by the Township. Trustees conveyed their thanks and encouragement to Rocky for his hard work.

Jim Hall reported he was in need of disposing of 2 generators and Engine 303, he inquired as to how he was to do this. He asked if he could place these items on governmentdeals.com for sale. After discussion, it was decided this would be the best route to take to dispose of these items.

Jim also asked about purchasing more fire coats for some additional members of the department. This discussion will continue next month once Jim and Annette Chapman, Fiscal Officer, come together with the paperwork from last purchase. Once they review, new coats will be ordered.

Hall also requested a purchase of an air pump/compressor. Jeff Robinson made a motion the Fire Department could make a purchase of an air pump/compressor with a cost up to \$2500.00. Gary Cunningham seconded this motion. (Resolution # 2009-14) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Sheriff Rocky Nelson stopped in to see what was new in the Township. He also reported that a packet of information on the speed indicator signs was being mailed to the township. This packet would include pictures, cost information, etc.
