Minutes of Leesburg Township Meeting
Held Monday, January 7, 2013**

The Trustees of Leesburg Township met in regular session at the Leesburg Township Fire/Road Maintenance and Storage Facility at 7:30 PM.

The following members were present: Bill Lowe, Jeff Robinson, Gary Cunningham and Clerk, Annette Chapman.

Others in attendance were: Fire Chief, Jim Hall, Malcolm Manville, Ben Laird, George Scheiderer and the Deputy Wilson.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Jeff Robinson.

Minutes of the meeting held December 23, 2012, were read and approved. Gary Cunningham made the motion to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Bill Lowe. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes)

Election of new officers for the year 2013 is as follows: Nomination of Gary Cunningham as Chairman and Bill Lowe as Vice-Chairman. Motion by Jeff Robinson to accept the officers as nominated. Seconded by Gary Cunningham. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2013-1)

Old Business:

Bill Lowe reported Mr. Slone's Zoning Appeal was denied by the Board of Zoning Appeals of Leesburg Township. Slone has 30 days to file an appeal with the Union County Prosecutor's Office. Slone reported he would be suing the Township for this denied zoning application.

Jeff Robinson reported the speed indicator signs are down again. Trustees are awaiting final repairs to the signs and replacement of batteries. This should resolve the long standing problems with these signs.

Bill Lowe reported having talked with the Ivan Miller family about the request for burial of Paul Miller's ashes on the family grave site. It was reported that the family has approved the burial on Ivan Miller's grave site. Fiscal Officer Chapman will contact the Paul Miller family to schedule burial date.

Old Business: Cont'd

George Scheiderer attended the meeting to report on last year's baseball season and to request another year as field supervisor. Trustees thanked Scheiderer for all his hard work and praised him for keeping the field in use and with good organization. Scheiderer reported approximately \$500 in expenses. These expenses were covered by the teams that used the field.

George reported some repairs that need to be made at the fields, which include the door to the concession stand building and the posts on the dug-outs at the back field. Robinson told George we would like to have him continue in 2013 to supervise/manage the fields. The Trustees offered any help they can provide for the upcoming season - they love to see the fields in use and will do what they can to help make that possible.

New Business:

Deputy Wilson stopped but had nothing new to report.

Jeff Robinson moved we continue using Jean Smith as clerk for the Zoning Boards and again pay Jean \$100 per Zoning meeting. Jeff also moved we continue paying both Zoning Boards members \$10 per meeting. In addition Zoning Inspector pay will continue at \$150 per month. Bill Lowe seconded this motion. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2013-2)

Bill Lowe moved Leesburg Township continue paying Fire Chief, Jim Hall, \$150 per month along with \$10 per run and per meeting and pay both Assistant Fire Chief/Mechanics, Kevin Dotson and Malcolm Manville, Assistant Fire Chief/Station , \$600 per year and \$10 per run and per meeting. In addition each fireman will continue to be reimbursed \$10 per run and \$5 per meeting at the end of 2013. Matt Flowers was appointed Medical Director for the Fire Department and will be paid \$600 per year along with \$10 per run and per meeting. Motion seconded by Jeff Robinson. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2013-3)

Bill Lowe moved that Malcolm Manville stay at \$12 per hour again this year for his work on maintenance and care for the Township facility. Motion seconded by Jeff Robinson. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2013-4)

The Trustees and Fiscal Officer's salaries will not change this year according to the State of Ohio's pay chart and according to the Ohio Revised Code for 2013.

Bill Lowe moved that again this year the Township cover the cost of Annual Township membership fees for all Trustees, Fiscal Officer, Fire Chief Hall, both Assistant Fire Chief Dotson and Manville along with Zoning Inspector Laird. The Trustee will also include Matt Flowers in this list of members for 2013. This will allow them to attend the Annual Conference if they so choose. Jeff Robinson seconded this motion. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2013-5)

Bill Lowe moved we accept the IRS maximum allowance for mileage for 2013. Jeff Robinson seconded this motion. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes). (Resolution # 2013-6)

Bill Lowe made a motion to hire a Court Reporter for ALL Zoning Appeals meeting for 2013. Jeff Robinson seconded this motion. (Resolution # 2013-7) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Fiscal Officer provided Payroll Certification sheets (time sheets) for 2013 which will need to be completed monthly by each Trustee as well as the Fiscal Officer. Jeff Robinson made the motion to pay Trustees 75% out of Gas Tax and 25% out of General Fund. Motion seconded by Bill Lowe. . (Resolution # 2013-8) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Jeff Robinson also moved that we pay to either Jim Hall or Malcolm Manville, \$25 per event for any special event opening/closing of the Township Hall for 2013. Motion seconded by Bill Lowe. . (Resolution # 2013-9) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Bill Lowe made a motion to accept the request by the Union County Engineer's office for the 2013 Township Highway System Mileage Certification. (Certification attached) Motion seconded by Jeff Robinson. . (Resolution # 2013-10) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Jeff Robinson moved the Township re-appoint the Zoning Board and Board of Appeals, adding Nigel Pence as the Board of Commissions alternate member. (Zoning committee list attached). Motion seconded by Bill Lowe. . (Resolution # 2013-11) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Chief Hall reported the fire department helmets are all out of date. They have a few samples coming to review. The helmets will cost approximately \$300 each to replace. Hall will report back when the decision on the type of helmet is made.

Review of the 2013 Appropriations ensued as presented by Fiscal Officer Chapman. The Trustees also reviewed the 2013 Certificate of the Total Amount from All Sources Available for Expenditures, and Balances. Fiscal Officer Chapman will finalize numbers and have them ready for final approval at the January 28th meeting.

At the conclusion of these discussions and with no further business, Jeff Robinson moved we adjourn the meeting. Motion seconded by Bill Lowe. Vote: Robinson (yes), Cunningham (yes) and Lowe (yes)

Others in attendance were: Fire Chief, Jim Hall, Asst. Fire Chief, Malcolm Manville, Zoning Inspector, Ben Laird, John Hower, Dorothy Pelanda and Deputy Wilson from the Union County Sheriff's office.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Gary Cunningham.

Minutes of the meeting held March 4, 2013, were read and approved. Bill Lowe made the motion to accept the minutes. Seconded by Jeff Robinson. Vote - Cunningham (yes), Lowe (yes), and Robinson (yes)

Old Business:

Deputy Wilson reported it was too early in the month to provide stats, so none were provided. The concern about cars parking to close to the side of the road in Pharisburg was once again discussed with the Deputy. He provided a phone number to call (937 645-4110) if violators are spotted.

Jeff Robinson reported we have submitted all necessary paperwork on the 13055 State Route 347 property demolition. Email confirmation was received that property will be demolished soon.

Jeff Robinson made a motion that a supplemental transfer in the General account appropriations be made as follows: \$510 from 1000-110-312 to 1000-110-211, \$300 from 1000-110-490 to 1000-110-211, \$450 from 1000-110-599 to 1000-110-211, \$200 from 1000-130-150 to 1000-110-213 and \$33 from 1000-110-345 to 1000-110-213 (See attached). Bill Lowe seconded the motion. Motion passed.

(Resolution # 2013-15) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Bill Lowe reported on the 19989 Pine Lane drainage problem. Bill has spoken with the Engineer's office. (Justin Story will be replacing Courtney Page at the office.) They recommended closing Pine Lane for 1 day to put new tile across the road at the repair site. Bill Lowe made a motion to hire the Union County Engineer to correct problem at 19989 Pine Lane. Jeff Robinson seconded this

motion. (Resolution # 2013-16) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Bill Lowe reported researching the title on the Magnetic Springs Ball Field Association. Jon Hall is named contact person at the State Office. All Trustees will talk with Jon if able to contact him (Hall is working out of state). Bill also reported visiting the ball fields - one ball field needs Roundup sprayed to control weeds. Lowe assured the group that the Township would spray.

Fire Chief Hall is still reviewing new helmets to find the best price for the purchase. He has a new brand to review and will report back to the Trustees in May.

New Business:

Dorothy Pelanda attended the meeting - she stated she is our "Voice at the State House". Dorothy reported on the "Moving Ohio Forward" program, which helps entities demo undesirable properties in the state. Jeff Robinson reported that the Township is currently utilizing the program and he commended Lucie McMahon, who he has been working the on the program. Property in Pharisburg will be demolished soon.

Dorothy also reported on policy updates in the state.

John Hower, of Rinehart Danner Insurance, attended to review the new Township insurance policy. He provided the new invoice with this year's premium which is up \$189 from last year. After review of the policy the Trustees discussed the policy and Jeff Robinson made a motion - if a previous, current or appointed Township Official is named in a law suit the Township will pay the deductible for the public official insurance policy. Motion seconded by Bill Lowe. (Resolution # 2013-17) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Zoning Inspector, Ben Laird, reported meeting the new owner of The Pit Stop and filled him in on some of the history with the Zoning Board.

Bill Lowe reported personally purchasing flowers for the Courtney Page funeral and splitting the cost with the other township elected officials.

Clean-up Day 2013 (April 20) is coming up this month and the Fire Department is ready to man it again this year.

The Union County Engineer's office presented the Equipment, Labor and Materials rates for 2013. Jeff Robinson moved the township accept the motion as stated for 2013. Motion seconded by Bill Lowe. (Resolution # 2013-18) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

With written request, Jim Hall requested copies of the 2012 Budget report, which will be provided him once Fiscal Officer Chapman receives her materials back from the Auditor of State.

Old Business:

Deputy Weller supplied the April Stats report to the Trustees. Bill Lowe reported bike riders again this year on Springdale Road running stop signs and other violations. The Trustees have repeatedly reported cars parking to close to the road on Route 4 in Pharisburg. Lowe reported having spoken to ODOT to see if there was anything they could recommend. He was told that it was up to the local law enforcement agency to challenge offenders and enforce the 8 foot from the road law. Lowe asked the Deputy pass this along to his department.

The Trustees again reported trash blowing out of Sims trucks coming from Honda, both on Route 4 and 347. Bill Lowe mentioned to the Deputy that he was told by ODOT that a large culvert on Route 4 would be replaced in 2016.

2013 Clean-up day was a success with the help of the Fire Department and Trustees. A load of metals was taken to Sims and after gas was paid to Rusty Lowe for the transport the balance of \$194 was given to the Fire Department.

New Business:

Jeff Stauch from the Union County Engineer's office attended the meeting with his staff. Stauch presented two resolutions to the Trustees. One for the repair of Pine Lane and the other for Springdale Road repair.

After discussion, Bill Lowe moved the Resolution for the repair of Pine Lane in the amount of \$1383.84 and the Resolution for the repair of Springdale Road North in the amount of \$820.62 be accepted by the Township. Jeff Robinson seconded this motion. (Resolution # 2013-19) Vote - Cunningham (yes), Robinson (yes), and Lowe (yes).

Joe Beightler attended the meeting to report on his appeal to ODOT on the Arbogast driveway permit. After some discussion, Bill Lowe recommended Beightler reapply with a permit to fill in the ditch. Lowe suggested he write a letter of support to go along with the permit application to ODOT.

Lowe reported during his conversation with ODOT he asked if the bushes at the corner of 37 and 347 could be removed due to obstruction of view. He also asked again about the LED stop signs. ODOT does not encourage the use of these signs but will authorize the installation if the Township cover the cost of the signs and installation. Lowe would like to apply again for the installation of such signs for the Township. After discussion, it was agreed that Bill should complete the application for the installation of the LED stop signs. Jeff Stauch, from the Engineer's office, will provide Bill with the name of the manufacturer used by the County for said signs.

Stauch reported they will be widening Claibourne Road and repairing the bridge at Blues Creek-Leeper Perkins Roads. Stauch presented an estimate and asked Township to participate in the cost of the repairs. He is seeking \$65,000 from the Township.

Trustees ask that Stauch give them time to discuss this request. The Engineering Team thanked the Trustees for their time and left to attend another Township meeting. At that point the Trustees discussed the request from the Engineer and Bill Lowe made a motion to provide \$35,000 toward the cost of the Blues Creek bridge repair. Fire Chief Hall reported the City of Marysville has asked the Fire Department to store a set of "Jaws of Life" which they will be able to utilize while storing at the Township facility. Jeff Robinson reported repairing the Magnetic Springs Ball Field mower and asked that he not be reimbursed for the costs. Jeff also reported no luck on contacting John Hall to discuss the transfer of the ball field to the Township.

The Township is currently undergoing the State Audit for 2011 and 2012, it has been requested that the Trustee approve a Fund Balance Adjustment for reallocation of expenditures for both years (recommendation attached to the minutes.) After discussion, Jeff Robinson moved the Township reallocate 2011 and 2012 expenditures as follows: Move \$4808.76 from Gas Tax back to General and move \$6770.19 from Fire Fund back to General.
