



Minutes of Leesburg Township Regular Meeting Monday, March 4, 2024

The Trustees of Leesburg Township met in a regular session.

Jeff called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The trustees reviewed the February 5, 2024 meeting minutes. Kevin made a motion, seconded by Jeff, to approve the February minutes. Motion approved.

Old Business

Fisher Excavating completed demolition on the house next to the firehouse. They leveled it and did an excellent job.

Jeff attended the February meeting regarding the new septic line. He said it was full of homeowners. Homeowners have until August to contact the Union County Health Department and tell them if they want to participate in the new system.

New Business

Chuck Woerner attended the meeting to inquire about the Township obtaining council to fight the solar project in Leesburg Township. Jeff informed him that the Union County Commissioner's Office was obtaining council to represent the county.

Jeff expressed his frustration to the Deputy about the high-performance motorcycles that speed along both directions on St. Rt. 4 in specific areas. The Deputy will check into it.

John Hower presented the new insurance policy for the new year. The Trustees reviewed.

Mike Justice attended to speak about his candidacy for Union County Sheriff.



Chad reported on the progress of the website. He also informed that Magnetic Springs signed the real estate contract with the North Union School Board. There is a clause that provides Leesburg Township first right to purchase the property and the school board second right, for the same \$1.00 purchase price, should Magnetic Springs resell the property.

Nigel had two permits from the previous month. One was a pole barn build with questions about zoning height restrictions. Nigel will approach it at the next BZA meeting. The Pit Stop has progressed some on the parking lot project.

Fire Chief Merrick reported receiving a grant from the county for Knox boxes for the residents in the fire district. He will hand them out to elderly homeowners. There is a new medic truck being delivered soon.

Mellisa reported that all 2023 financials were complete and an ad was put in the paper informing the public.

The F.O. circulated warrants, purchase orders, vouchers and receipts for trustee approval.

Jeff made a motion, seconded by Kevin, to adjourn the board meeting. Motion passed unanimously.
