



Minutes of Leesburg Township Regular Meeting Monday, February 3, 2025

The Trustees of Leesburg Township met in a regular session.

Kevin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Minutes were reviewed from the previous meeting. Motion to accept the minutes from January 6 made by Jeff. Bill seconded the motion, motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

Nigel spoke to Jared Converse and reminded him that he needs a conditional use permit if he wants to use his barn as a rented wedding venue. In order to obtain a permit, he needs to plead his case to the BZA.

Nigel informed the Trustees that the landowner of the wetlands on St. Rt. 37 is looking to sell eight of the acres split into two lots. This would not be possible without breaking the 3:1 rule for building.

Jeff heard from Ag Pro the cemetery bucket we ordered would be available this week for pick up. The cost is \$1960 for a 36" bucket.

Bill secured the dumpsters for clean up day. There will be six 30-yard dumpsters and one additional for scrap metal. Bill made a motion to accept the bid from Beale's Hauling LLC for the dumpsters. Jeff seconded the motion. Motion passed.

New Business

John Hower attended the meeting to discuss the renewal of the insurance policy. Bill asked if we needed to acquire building insurance from them while the new building is



being built. John said the builder can provide it or Rinehart can. John will send a quote for it. He will send us a new insurance quote with the new building added to the policy.

Kevin made a motion to accept the invitation to bid that Bill has drafted for the new building. The bid will be advertised in the newspaper twice in the month of February. Jeff seconded the motion, motion passed.

Chad informed the Trustees that the murals on the Magnetic Springs Community Center have been taken down to be repaired. He also informed the Trustees that the Post Office is struggling to keep decent hours, cleanliness and correct mail sorting. The Richwood Library approached Chad about conducting an open library at the Community Center twice a week. This will target people who cannot travel to the library. He also found out the Army Core of Engineers has to issue a permit to allow entry into the waterway to fix the bridge. Once that happens the bid can open up. The bid should be open by the end of February.

Bill moved to accept the amended lease agreement between Leesburg Township Board of Trustees and Northwestern Joint Fire District for the term of the lease. The amended lease agreement added the following: *The term of this lease agreement shall be deemed retroactive to cover periods January 1, 2024 and commence thereafter and shall remain in effect until either party gives 120 days advance notice prior to any cancellation.* Jeff seconded the motion. Motion passed by all.

The F.O. circulated warrants, purchase orders, vouchers, automatic payments and receipts for trustee approval.

Bill made a motion, seconded by Jeff, to adjourn the board meeting. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned.





New Business

Thayne is attending the meeting in support of Nigel regarding the Agritourism verbiage in the Township's zoning language. Nigel encourages the update, along with the LUC, to make more clear some of the zoning questions regarding Agritourism. The Trustees agree there needs to be more clarification regarding the rules.

Chad has an update on the bridge Ohio Department of Transportation. They are projecting the bridge project to be complete by August. He also has an update from the

Department of History

History 100: Introduction to Canadian History

- Modern Canada: The role of the federal government and the development of the Canadian nation.

Students will be expected to read and discuss the assigned texts, as well as to participate in class discussions and presentations.
