The Trustees of Leesburg Township met in a regular session.

Kevin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Old Business

Bill sent a text message to Thayne after the last meeting This was in regards to our decision to go forward with prosecution of Mr. Sercher's property on Sandusky Rd. No word back as of tonight's meeting.

Gene is ready to go forward on the township storage building. The city permit was recently approved. Breaking Ground should start next week. Fisher Excavating may start on the ballfield parking lot soon. Park Enterprise was out repairing the walking path and the last of the bills are in.

New Business

Chad mentioned that the Magnetic Springs bridge will open this week. He asked the deputy for extra patrol in the village as the resident children have become accustomed to playing in the streets for the last year and a half.

The bids for the sewer project will be opened on October 8, 2025 by the Village Council. Chad presented the Trustees with a map that shows community improvements they would like to accomplish in the Village. Leesburg Township owns plots of land where the Village wants to build. Bill suggested Leesburg Township donate the land to the Village of Magnetic Springs. Chad will have a property purchase agreement drawn up to bring to the next month meeting for review.



Justin Ufferman, Superintendent of North Union Schools, attended the meeting to give a school district progress report. Justin would like to put together a committee of one representative from each township and school in the district to collaborate and share information.

Assistant Chief Cook informed the Trustees of several grants the fire department received for things such as new gloves and hoods, power cart on new medic and SCBA's for the Firemen.

The Trustees discussed the job description for the cemetery mowing position. We will need to post the job online.


LUC dropped off the amended zoning books to be signed and recorded at the County Records Office.

The F.O. circulated warrants, purchase orders, vouchers, automatic payments and receipts for trustee approval.


Jeff made a motion, seconded by Kevin, to adjourn the board meeting. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned.
